*Rehearsal Tuesday 5th December – Primary 1, 2 & 3 classes only

- Children should be left at Ballydown Church from 8.45am onwards.
- Breakfast club will operate as normal in school and staff will transport P1-P3 children to the church for the practice.
- School bags are not needed for P1-P3, but children should bring a lunch box if they are having packed lunch. Please ensure dinners are booked on the app.
- They will **not need a snack** as the school will provide a snack for all children at the church hall.
- A bus will transport children back to school for lunch time at 12 noon.
- Costumes are not required for this rehearsal.
- **KS2 Choir** will walk up on Tuesday afternoon for a rehearsal at the church. They should come to school as normal on Tuesday morning.

Morning service 9:45am Wednesday 6th Dec.

- P1-P3 & Choir children should be left at **Ballydown Church from 8.45am onwards**. They will watch a DVD in the **Main Hall**.
- Breakfast club will operate as normal in school and staff will transport P1-P3 & Choir children to the church for the service.
- P1 -P3 should come to the church dressed in their costume.
- KS2 Choir wear full formal school uniform (shirt, ties, black shoes, girls white knee socks).
- ALL P1-P3 children to go home after their performance (approx. 11am). KS2 Choir will return to school.
- Wednesday 6th December Primary 4, 5, 6 & 7 classes Normal school drop off will operate for these classes. They will walk to and from Ballydown Church to attend the school carol service @ 9.45am. Classroom assistants and teachers will accompany the children. Please ensure children wear coats (all children will wear hi-vis vests). Any parents able to assist and supervise the walking of children to the church would be greatly appreciated.

Evening Service 6.30pm Wednesday 6th Dec.

- Children meet in the Main Hall of Ballydown Church @ 6.00pm sharp.
- P1-P3 should come dressed in their costumes
- KS2 Choir wear full formal school uniform (shirt, ties, black shoes, girls white knee socks).
